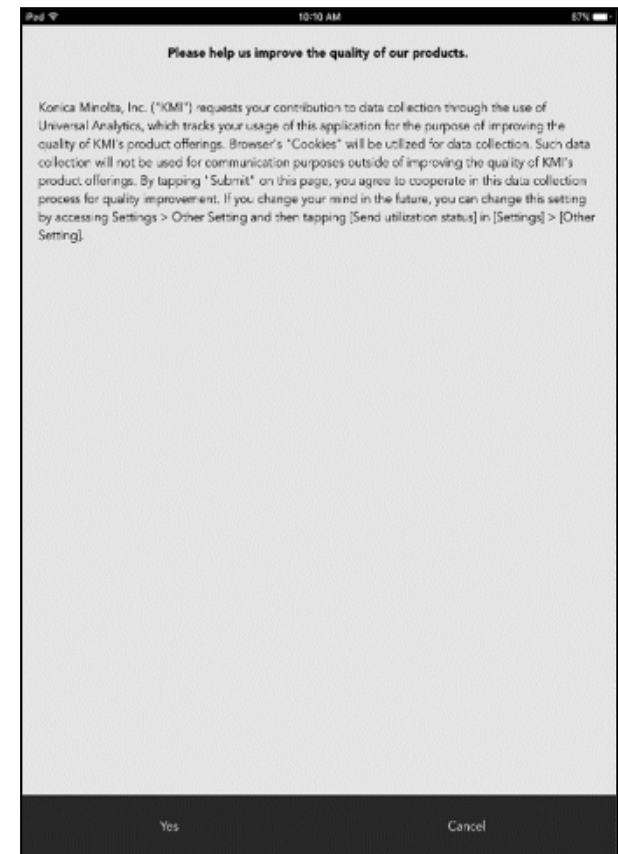


## Google Analytics User Approval

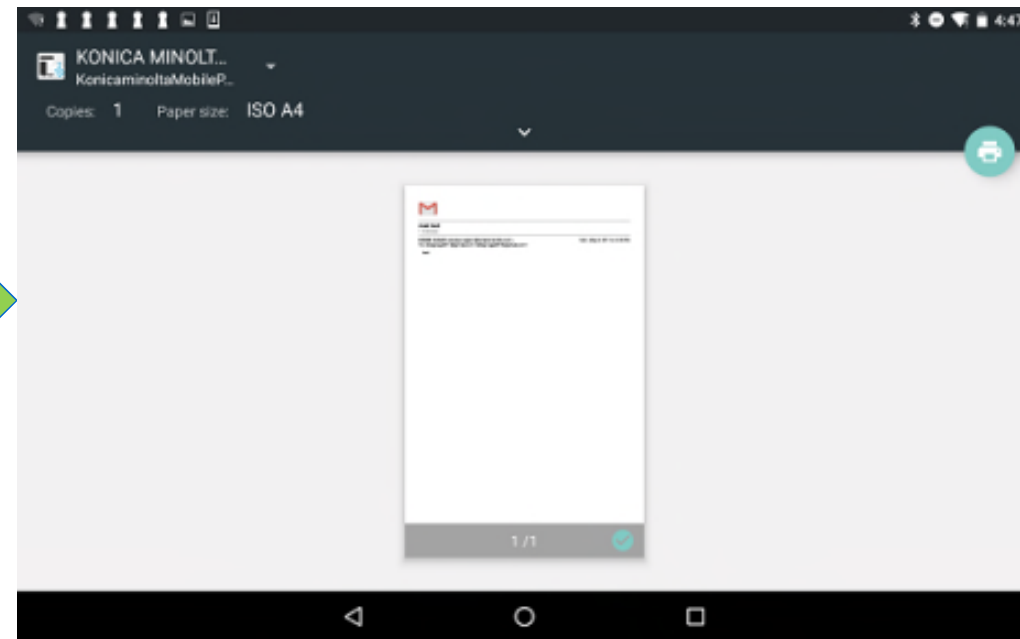
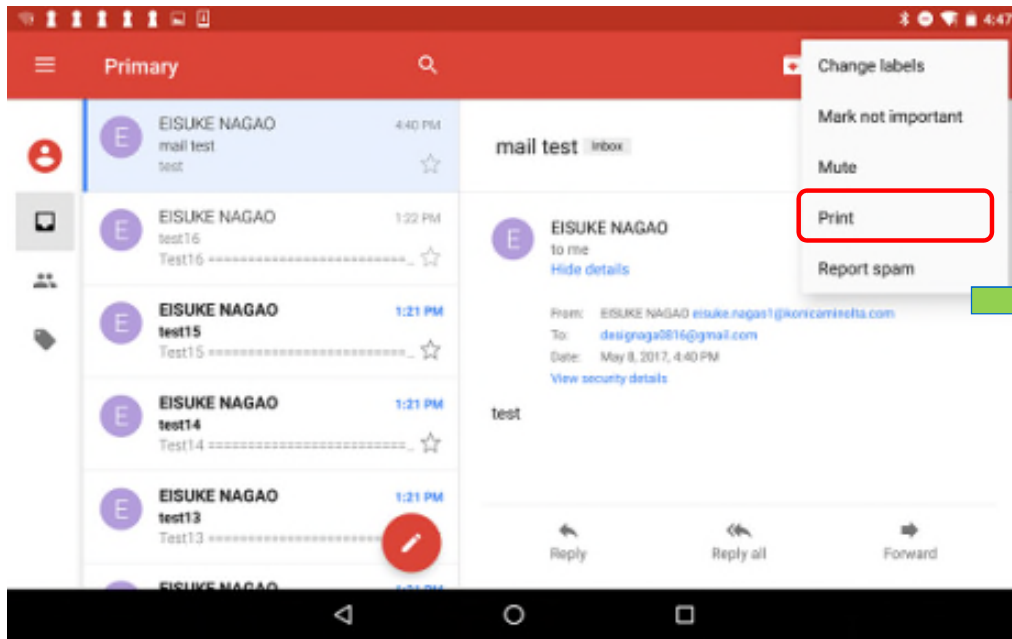
## AIRPRINT

When User Authentication is set on the registered MFPs, enter the authentication information in the Konica Minolta Mobile Print App

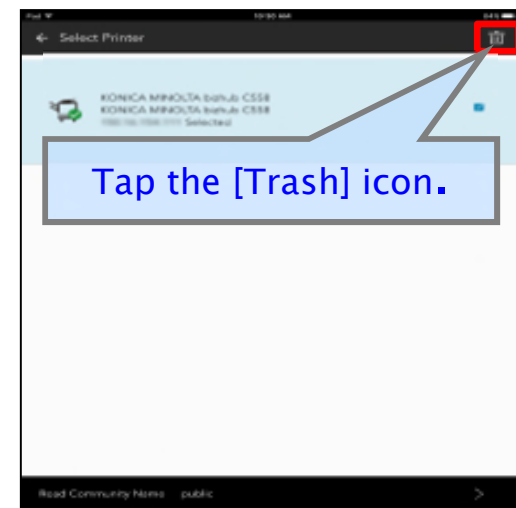
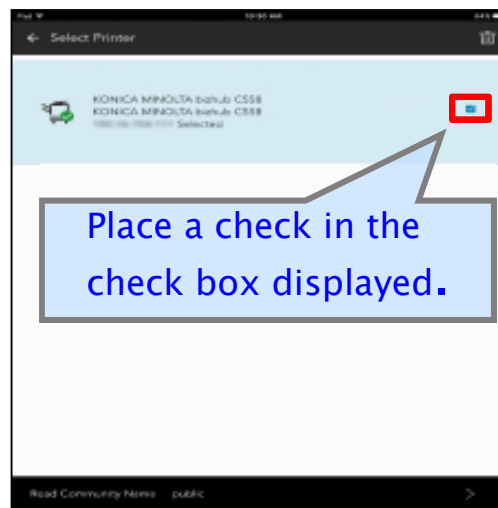
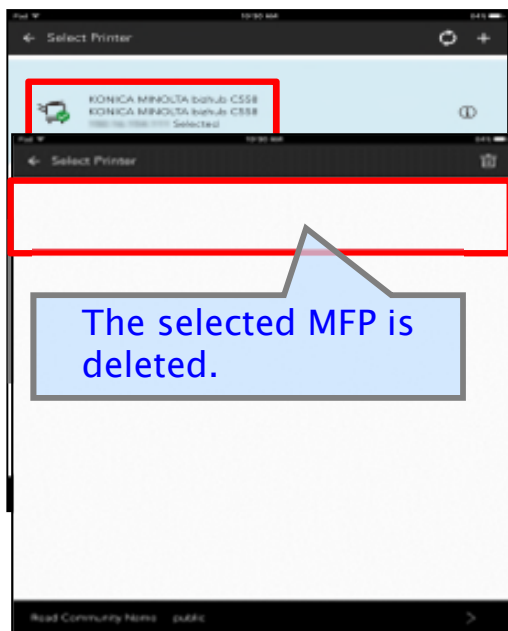

## Additional Notes for Konica Minolta Mobile Print when registering an Email Exchange/EWS

### For Microsoft Exchange Online / Office 365

1. Access your journaling mailbox account using Outlook Web App (OWA)
2. Click **Options > See All Options > Account > My Account > Settings for POP, IMAP, and SMTP access**
3. In the list of entries, locate the server name. The URL of exchange web service for the mailbox is the URL: [https://<ONLINE\\_URL>/EWS/Exchange.asmx](https://<ONLINE_URL>/EWS/Exchange.asmx)

### For Microsoft Exchange (on premise)

1. The URL can be composed using the following syntax: [https://<EXCHANGE\\_SERVER\\_HOSTNAME>/EWS/Exchange.asmx](https://<EXCHANGE_SERVER_HOSTNAME>/EWS/Exchange.asmx)

### Using Microsoft Exchange Management Shell

1. Open Exchange Management Shell and run the following command.
2. `Get-WebServicesVirtualDirectory |Select name, *url* | fl`
